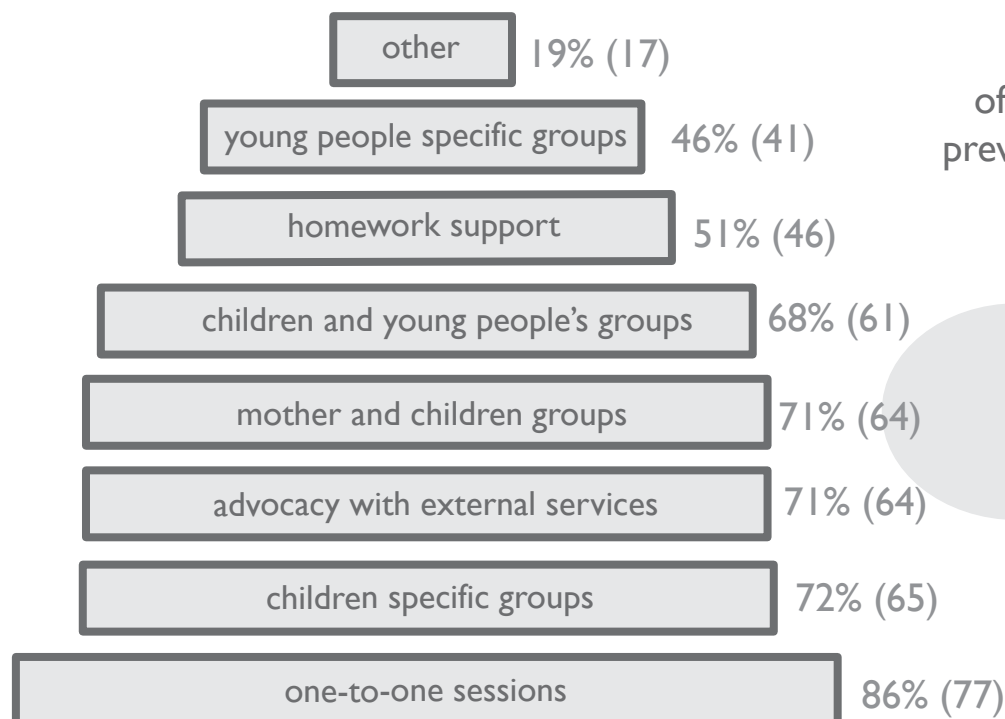

Domestic violence has a devastating impact on children and young people which can last into adulthood. They need specialist services to support them while their mother is also getting support. A range of services are provided, from counselling to address the trauma, to help with finding and settling into a new school, to supporting children and young people to rebuild their lives.

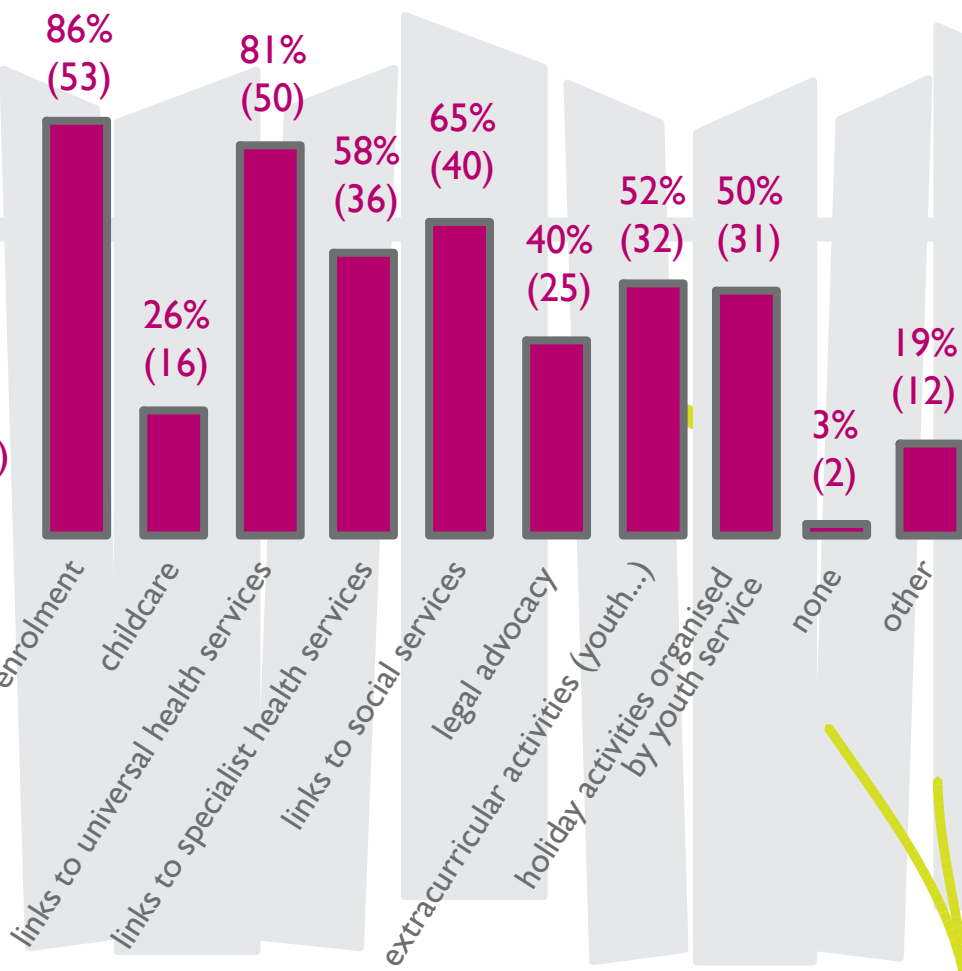
